During the FY 22-23, Gila Regional Medical Center focused on capital improvements to provide better quality for patients who need medical care. GRMC, along with community resources and state legislators, advanced the quality of care for patients through the following projects:

- Replaced our fetal heart monitors and mobile work stations in MATCH
- Purchased new DEXAscans to test for bone density
- Purchased new 3-D mammography machine
- Replaced the operating room lights and tables
- Purchased two new extrication sets and heart monitors for EMS
- Installed a new MOSAIQ software upgrade for our Cancer Center
- Purchased a new urinalysis machine
- Added new testing capabilities to our laboratory
- Purchased new BRODA chair for our Rehabilitation Center for inpatients
